Sesquicentennial Corner

From our Church History:

One special feature added to PUMC’s Palm Sunday observance began in 1982 during the tenure of Rev. Clyde Allan (Bud) Cox as Senior Pastor. Pastor Bud asked for volunteers to create a small cross from trimming and folding pieces of palm leaves obtained from a local florist shop. Several offered, including Bernadine McFarren, John and Ethel Jenkins, Jackie Crouse, and Bobbie Sebring. In subsequent years Bernadine and John were asked to create an ongoing core of helpers. One of these crosses (with an attaching pin) was offered to each of those attending the Sunday service. Today this observance continues with the efforts of Connie Stokes (daughter of Bernadine) plus Bobbie Sebring and Jackie Crouse still among the helpers to make these same cross pins from palm leaves obtained from Flowers on Main. A note Connie sends to Sue Cox (widow of Pastor Bud Cox) assures her this tradition continues.
