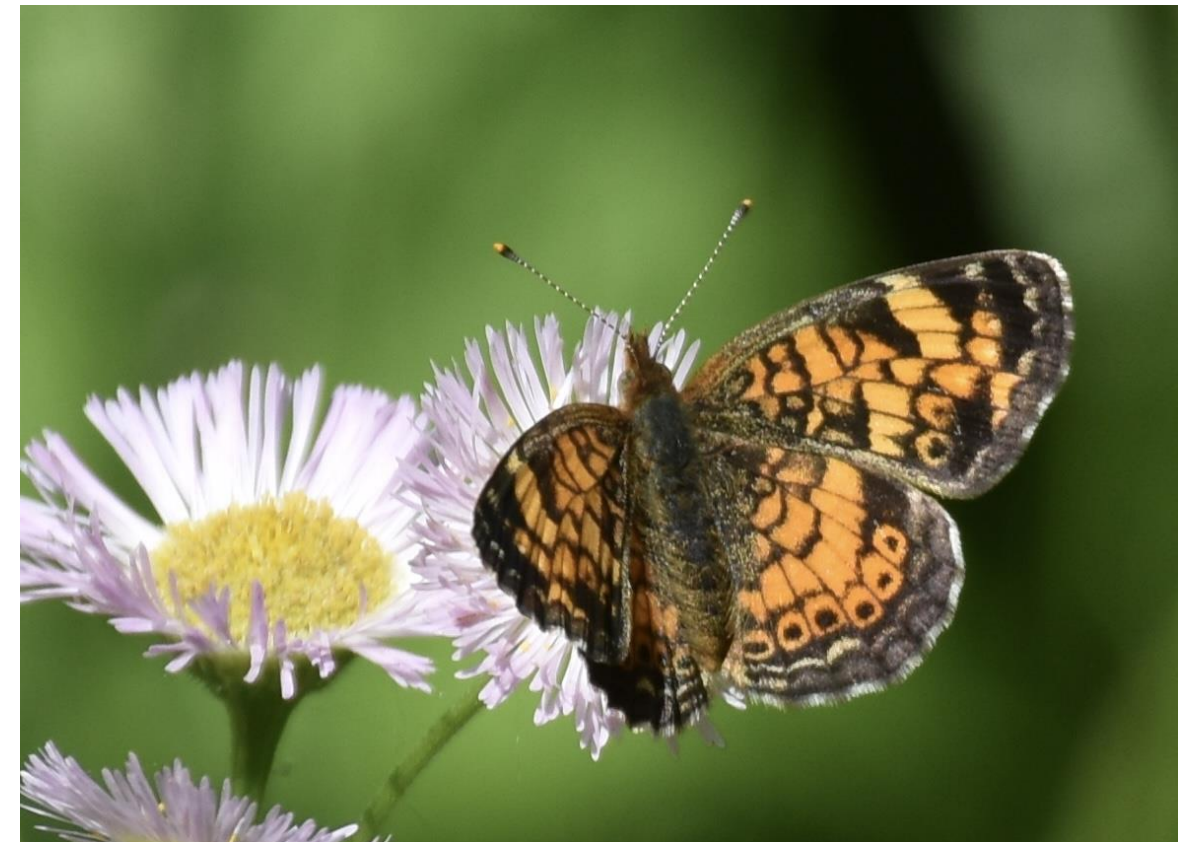

Austin Kalb (son of Sam & Lauren Kalb / grandson of Rev. Jerry & Roberta Kalb & Lee & Cheryl Behnke)

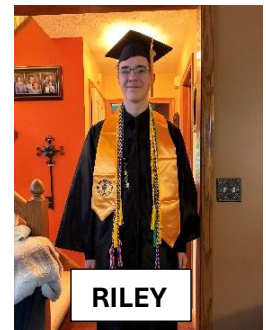
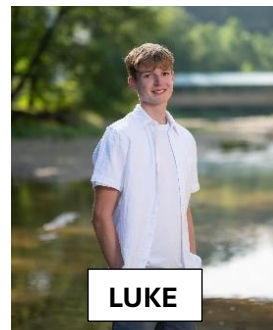
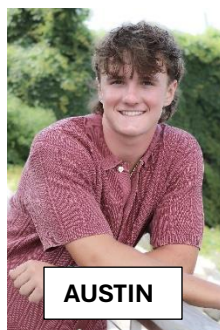
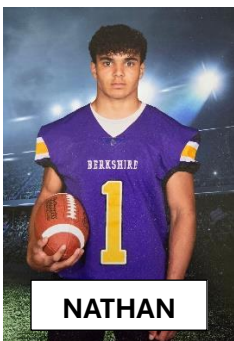
